Secretary Miller:

Article 2, Section 10 of the Nevada Constitution and NRS294A.100 limit contributions to an individual candidate to \$5,000 for the primary election and \$5,000 for the general election. According to the Aurora Campaign Finance Disclosure database maintained by the Nevada Secretary of State, Hutchison & Steffen, LLC (Contributor) and Mark A. Hutchison (Recipient) may have violated these limits.

Hutchison & Steffen, LLC donated a total of \$11,125.78 in in-kind donations to the campaign of Mark A. Hutchison for his campaign for Nevada State Senate District 6 from September 18, 2012 through November 1, 2012:

September 18, 2012.....	\$8,683.67
October 31, 2012.....	\$1,728.55
November 1, 2012.....	\$193.83
November 1, 2012.....	\$519.73
Total	\$11,125.78

These contributions appear to be a clear violation of the Nevada Constitution and NRS294A.100.

By this letter the undersigned hereby requests that these contributions be investigated and, if applicable, both Hutchison & Steffen, LLC and Mark A. Hutchison be charged as outlined in NRS294A.100(3).

In addition NRS294A.420(5)(e) specifically allows you to take into consideration "Any knowledge or experience the candidate, person, committee, political party or nonprofit corporation has with the provisions of this chapter." Please be advised Senator Mark A. Hutchison promotes himself in person, and on the Hutchison & Steffen website, as an "Election Law and Government Ethics Attorney," please see attached screen shot from the Hutchison & Steffen, LLC website.
